**Agency:** Washington State Patrol

**Subject of possible rule making:** Fire Marshal Standards

**Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject:** RCW 18.20.130, 18.46.110, 70.62.290 and 74.15.050

**Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish:**

Updates to Chapter 212-12 WAC are necessary to clean up and provide clarification to the existing language to ensure the rules reference and comply with current laws in the state of Washington.
